#1. Choose your approach

- Do you want an online book drive with a local bookstore or one of Reach Out and Read Minnesota's partner vendors (<u>Books4School</u>, <u>Scholastic</u> or <u>AllAboutBooks</u>)? Our partner vendors can usually provide more books per dollar, but we also love to support Minnesota's local bookstores.
